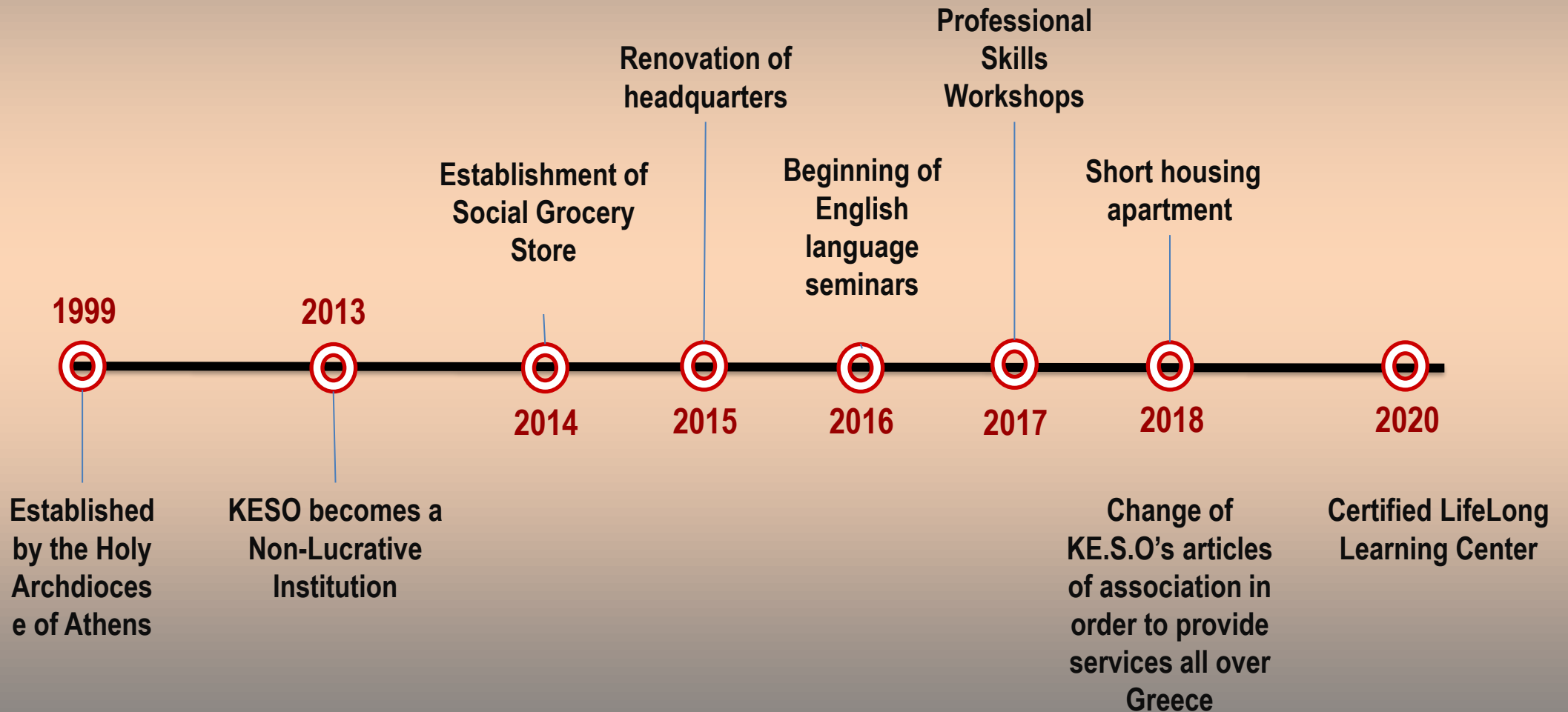
The Family Support Center

- Was established in 1999 by the **Holy Archdiocese of Athens** (Legal Person Governed by Public Law).
- In February of 2013 it became a **Non-Lucrative Church Institution** (Legal Person Governed by Private Law)
- In October of 2018 it became Non-Lucrative Church Institution **of Panhellenic range**.
- In September of 2020 our training center has been **certified as a Lifelong Learning Center, level I**
